

GIANT ROSETTE

“My customer wants a very large rosette” this is something we hear very frequently, so I thought I would run through a ‘Blue Peter’ type of assembly. The picture shows one we made earlier this week. The selling price was £48.00 +VAT. It took about 1.5 hours to make.



Use a round template the size you want. A plate is ideal as it keeps your fingers away from the knife. Cut out the card.



You need to find the centre. Draw any two lines across the circle. Carefully mark the middle of each line. (If you paid attention during geometry lessons you will know this trick)



Using a piece of card place it along the line, and stop at the mark you made for the middle. Draw a line through the centre of the circle. Do this for both lines.



Where the two lines cross is the centre of the circle. You can now draw on the circles for the number of tiers of ribbon you are going to use.



Glue on your ribbon as usual



Using a smaller circle template cut out your centre board



We printed the centre on an inkjet and cut it out. Glue it on using a pritt stick glue.



Using a craft knife can be dangerous. Take precautions to stop any items slipping, and make sure you do not cut through the card and damage a table top.
